1-8 Four hands around and back
9-12 $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ Ladies turn by the right hand back to place
$13-161^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ Men turn by the left hand, finishing in original places in promenade hold with partner.
17-24 Using 2 bars of music, $1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }}$ couples pass by the right shoulder. Again, using 2 bars of music, pass the next couple by the left shoulder. Repeat this pattern to finish the phrase, changing to nearer hand hold at the end of bar 24.
25-32 Couples will change places using arches. To begin, $1^{\text {st }}$ couple dance under the arch for 2 bars, then make the arch for 2 bars WHILE $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple make the arch for 2 bars, then dance under the arch for 2 bars. Repeat this pattern for 8 bars, finishing beside partner facing a new couple, ready to begin again.

1-8 All clap \& 1 s cross passing RSh, cast to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place \& dance RH across with 3 s
9-16 All clap \& 1 s cross passing RSh, cast to $1^{\text {st }}$ place \& dance LH across with 2 s
17-24 $1 M+3 L$ change places RH \& $1 L+3 M$ change places $R H$ (as $1 M+3 L$ loop round), $1 M+3 L$ change places RH (as $1 \mathrm{~L}+3 \mathrm{M}$ loop round) \& $1 \mathrm{~L}+3 \mathrm{M}$ cross LH 1 L ending in $2^{\text {nd }}$ place (as 1 M casts to $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{pl}$ )
25-32 $2 s+1 s$ dance R\&L

17-24 $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ dance LSh reels of 3 (1s dance up to start)
25-32 1s turn 2H in centre \& end BtoB (Lady facing up \& Man down), 1 s circle 3H round to left (Lady with 2 s \& Man with 3 s ) ending $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{pl}$

1-8 1 s cross RH to double triangle position with $2 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ \& set, 1 s cast up to top \& dance down until they are between 2s \& 3s
9-16 1 L dances $R \mathrm{R}$ across with $2 \mathrm{M}+3 \mathrm{M}$ while 1 M dances LH across with $2 \mathrm{~L}+3 \mathrm{~L}$, 1 s followed by $2 \mathrm{~s}+3$ s dance down centre
17-24 3 s followed by $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}$ dance up \& $3 \mathrm{~s}+2 \mathrm{~s}$ cast down to places, 1 L dances LH across with $2 \mathrm{M}+3 \mathrm{M}$ while 1 M dances RH across with $2 \mathrm{~L}+3 \mathrm{~L}$

17-24 $1 \mathrm{~s}+2 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ circle 6 H round $\&$ back
25-32 1 s dance $1 / 2$ Figs of 8 round 2 s , cross RH \& cast 1 place

## 32 bar Reel, Around the Room

## $1^{\text {st }}$ couple faces counter-clockwise; $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple facing clockwise

1-8 Four hands around and back
$9-121^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ Ladies turn by the right hand back to place
$13-161^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ Men turn by the left hand, finishing in original places in promenade hold with partner.
$17-24$ Using 2 bars of music, $1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }}$ couples pass by the right shoulder. Again, using 2 bars of music, pass the next couple by the left shoulder. Repeat this pattern to finish the phrase, changing to nearer hand hold at the end of bar 24.
25-32 Couples will change places using arches. To begin, $1^{\text {st }}$ couple dance under the arch for 2 bars, then make the arch for 2 bars WHILE $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple make the arch for 2 bars, then dance under the arch for 2 bars.
Repeat this pattern for 8 bars, finishing beside partner facing a new couple, ready to begin again.
